Before Me. the undersigned authority personally appeared _____ who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 30 day of NOVEMBER, 2019, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

COMMIT THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (\$1,000 OR MORE) WITHIN THE CITY OF MOUNT DORA, LAKE COUNTY FLORIDA.

On Saturday November 30th, 2019, at 1411 hours, units responded to intersection of 5th Avenue and Dora Dardy Way, Mount Dora, Florida in reference to criminal mischief.

I met with victim, Phil Barnard, who was identified through his Florida driver license. Phil provided a sworn verbal and written affidavit indicating his intent to prosecute, stating the following:

Phil stated, he observed a male and female behind a vehicle on a private lot, located behind 322 North Alexander Street, Mount Dora, Florida. Phil stated he noticed a black drawing on the wall, behind the above-mentioned location. Phil stated the unknown female was possibly white, with black hair, wearing a black tee shirt and overalls, with pens all inside her pockets. The male was described as a white man, with brown hair, wearing a yellow shirt and tan shorts. When Phil confronted the two suspects, the male and female proceeded to leave the scene. Phil stated he pursued the male suspect, but lost sight of the female. Phil was able to catch the male suspect and notified law enforcement.

Phil stated there was property damage at Magical Meat Boutique. The property located at 322 North Alexander Street is owned by Magical Meat Boutique, as well. The damage done to the train car that is being leased by Magical Meat Boutique cost approximately \$80.00. In addition, the damage done to the wall on the rear of the business, which is also being leased by Magical Meat Boutique cost approximately \$120.00. Total estimated damage between the two locations was estimated at \$200.00 to repair the damaged items.

Due to verbal and sworn written statement Phil provided of the incident, Weiss was placed under arrest. A search was conducted and Sergeant Young located various color permanent markers in Weiss's lower right pocket of his cargo shorts. The items found in Weiss's possession were permanent markers matching the colors of the drawings on private properties.

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared _____ who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 30 day of NOVEMBER, 2019, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

When Mount Dora Police Department units met with the male suspect (who was identified as Josef B. Weiss, through his Florida driver license). I read Weiss his Miranda Rights from my preprinted Mount Dora Police Department Miranda Rights Card. Weiss advised he understood his rights and wished to waive them and answer law enforcement's questions. Weiss denied any of the drawings at the various locations, and did not want provide any information about the female. However, when speaking with Sergeant Young, Weiss stated he was a lookout for his girlfriend who committed the graffiti on the business. Taking a closer look at Weiss's hands he had fresh paint/marks on his hands.

During our investigation, Sergeant Young discovered additional graffiti drawings, matching the other drawings, located in different areas. Two other graffiti drawings were founded at Lake County Arms, located at 112 West 5th Avenue, Mount Dora, Florida.

The owner Mark provided a sworn verbal and written affidavit indicating his intent to prosecute:


Mount Dora Police Department contacted him and stated that graffiti had been done to the rear of his establishment. Mark stated there were two areas that were vandalized. Mark estimated the total property damage for each area to cost approximately \$100.00; which brings the total property damage to \$200.00.


As Officer Rice and I were canvassing the area for additional graffiti; I discovered more graffiti paintings on a Mount Dora public restroom (woman's restroom) near 237 West 4th Avenue, Mount Dora, Florida. The graffiti was on the exterior handicap door within the woman's restroom. A city employee stated the estimated cost would be \$600.00 to repair the damaged door.

I was then flagged down by Barrell of Books and Games Store Owner, Cristine Stile who provided a sworn verbal and written affidavit, indicating her intent to prosecute for the following:

Stile stated she was informed that the northwest side of her building had a graffiti drawing matching the other report graffiti drawings. Stile estimated the total cost of damage was estimated at \$150.00 to repair.

I was then flagged down by Papilio Store Manager, Henry Ollendick who provided a sworn verbal and written affidavit, indicating his intent to prosecute for the following:

Ollendick was approached by law enforcement that there was graffiti on the eastside of his establishment. Ollendick stated the estimated cost would be \$150.00 to repair the damaged area.

Total amount in all property damage came out to be approximately 1,300.00. Digital photographs were taken and attached to this report. Weiss was secured and placed in my marked patrol vehicle and transported to the Lake County Jail located in Tavares, Florida.
