PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared Hutchison G 0366 who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 4 day of DECEMBER, 2020 in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

COMMIT THE OFFENSE OF FALSE STATEMENTS IN AN OFFICIAL PROCEEDING ALLEGED CRIME IN THE CITY OF MOUNT DORA, LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

On Monday, November 03, 2020 at approximately 2043 Hours, Mount Dora Police Officers responded to 1345 North Grandview Street (T&N Market) in the City of Mount Dora, Lake County, Florida, in reference to shooting that occurred.

A black male subject entered the establishment and shot the owners of the store. The female died on scene, and the male passed away the following day. According to the video that was obtained, Undrea Dixon entered the store approximately 1 minute after the shooting. Dixon walked into the store, looked around and looked behind the counter, seeing the male down on the floor and hearing his moaning out in pain. In a recorded statement, Dixon admitted to going into the store, and heard what she thought was a moan. She looked over the counter and observed the male on the floor.

Dixon left the establishment, returning to her home. Dixon returned to the scene approximately 4 hours later, only to be recognized by Cpl. Joseph via her clothing via video. When Dixon met with Cpl. Joseph, of the Mount Dora Police Department, she provided a sworn written statement that she entered the store, saw no one, and heard no one. She left the store and returned home, later meeting with Officers.

Based on the events that occurred Undrea Dixon was asked to come down to the Mount Dora Police Department. Dixon was asked about her affidavit she signed on November 30, 2020. She later admitted to officers via video that she actually saw the male subject on the floor, left the store and went home. She also advised that she knowingly gave a false statements to Law enforcement in an official proceedings. She knew that the statements that she provided under oath to not be the truth, and provided the statements anyway. Approximately 18 minutes elapsed before another person entered the store and called 911. Based on the severity of the incident a double murder we are requesting no bond be issued.
