PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:
 (Specify probable cause, for each charge)
 Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared KRUEGER L 0364 who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 16 day of SEPTEMBER 2019 in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

Commit the offense of Carjacking with the use of a firearm, Possession of a firearm by convicted felon, Possession of Methamphetamine, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On September 16, 2019 at approximately 1431 hours, officers responded to the area of CVS (18915 US HWY 441) in reference to a carjacking involving a firearm. While responding to the scene, the Mount Dora Police Communications Unit advised the victim's vehicle, a black Chevrolet Avalanche, left the area traveling north on US HWY 441 towards Leesburg with a black Volk's Wagon directly behind it.

While traveling south on US HWY 441, I observed a black Chevrolet Avalanche, with a black Volk's Wagon directly behind it turn into the Target Parking lot at 17450 US HWY 441. Believing these two vehicles to be the same as described by the victim, I conducted a traffic stop on the Chevrolet. Once additional officers arrived, the driver (Michael Knapp) was removed from the vehicle and secured.


Sgt. Strykowski located the Volk's Wagon on the west side of the Target parking lot, with a white male present.

While detaining Knapp, Sgt. Figueroa and Det. Smith responded to CVS to speak with the victim John Miller. Miller advised he was in the Public parking lot (18955 US HWY 441) when a black Volk's Wagon pulled behind his vehicle. Two white males were inside the vehicle with a white female driver. The males exited the vehicle and approached his vehicle. One suspect entered the front seat passenger's door and pointed a gun at Miller's head, touching the gun to the right side of his head. Miller exited the vehicle and the male suspect then left the area in Miller's vehicle. The second male suspect jumped back into the Volk's Wagon and theft the area behind Miller's vehicle.

Sgt. Figueroa responded to Target with Miller for the purpose of identifying both males. Upon arrival, Miller positively identified both the occupant of the Volk's Wagon (Michael Mulhern) and the driver of Miller's vehicle (Michael Knapp).

Both were placed under arrest and transported to the Mount Dora Police Department. Miller's vehicle was search with his consent. Upon entering the vehicle, Sgt. Helfant immediately located a small plastic bag containing a crystal substance between the center armrest area and the front passenger's seat. A glass pipe was located by Det. Smith on the floor near the front passenger's seat. A Glock handgun was located under the rear seat near the center of the vehicle by Sgt. Figueroa.

A criminal history search showed Mulhern was also a convicted felon with his most recent felony conviction on September 21, 2018 for Possession of Synthetic Cannabinoid.


Both Knapp and Mulhern were transported to the Lake County Jail without incident. The female driver was not located or identified.


