Narrative

On Tuesday, July 7, 2020 at approximately 2144 hours I responded to [REDACTED] East Jackson Avenue in reference to a subject who had been shot.

While en-route to the call, the only information the individual who called 911 was able to advise was that a female subject was shot and currently at the [REDACTED] East Jackson Avenue address. Upon my arrival to the scene I observed a black female in the front entrance of the address and myself, and other officers with the Mount Dora Police Department attempted to render aid to the female. [REDACTED]

Shortly after this occurred and Lake County Deputies assisted in crowd control, we were able to have medical staff enter the area and provide lifesaving care to the victim. While this was occurring, officers were informed of another victim who had been shot in the area of Grant Avenue and Clayton Street. I did not respond to that location due to the current crime scene at [REDACTED] East Jackson Avenue. I stood by the scene and informed individuals to not enter through the front entrance of the residence due to the active crime scene. It was later determined by officers on scene, the second victim is [REDACTED] who was suffering from multiple gun show wounds.

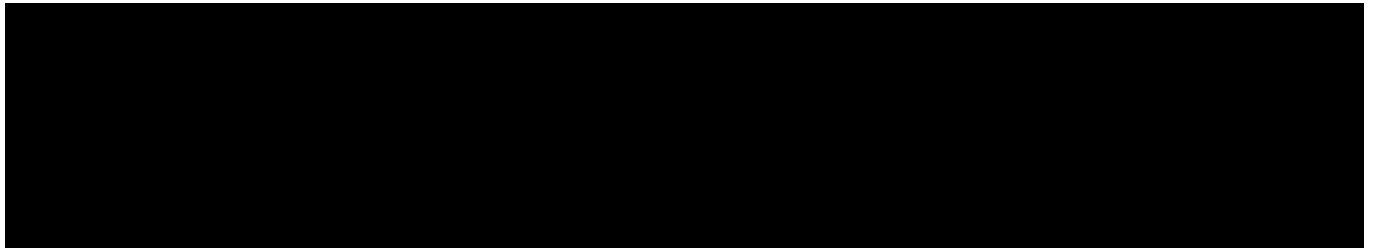
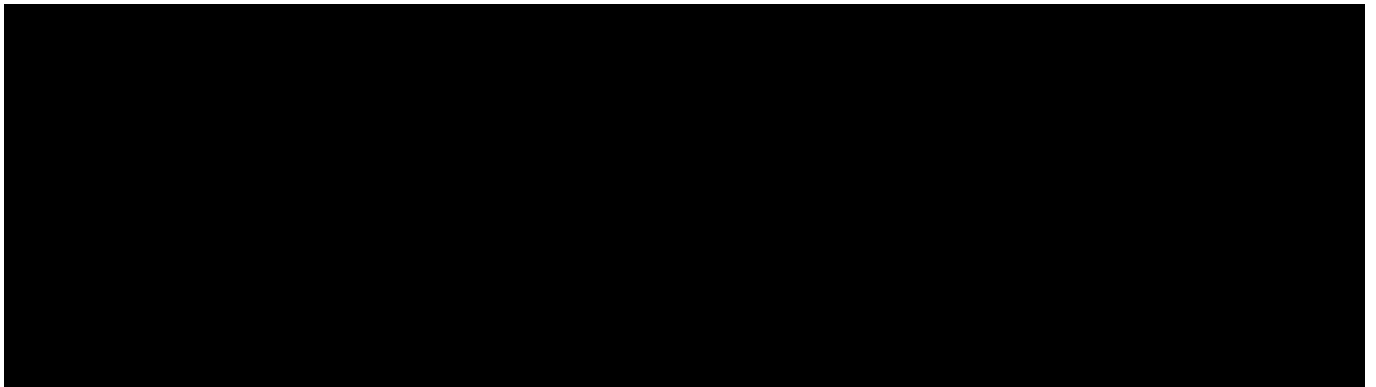
